

Putting students first: How MacEwan University modernized resource sharing with Rapido


A teaching-focused institution

The solution: Rapido integrated with Alma and Primo


Rapido stood out for its deep integration within the Clarivate ecosystem, providing a unified experience for both staff and users.

By adopting Clarivate’s interconnected solutions, MacEwan has strengthened both its local services and its place in the broader academic library community.


Looking ahead
