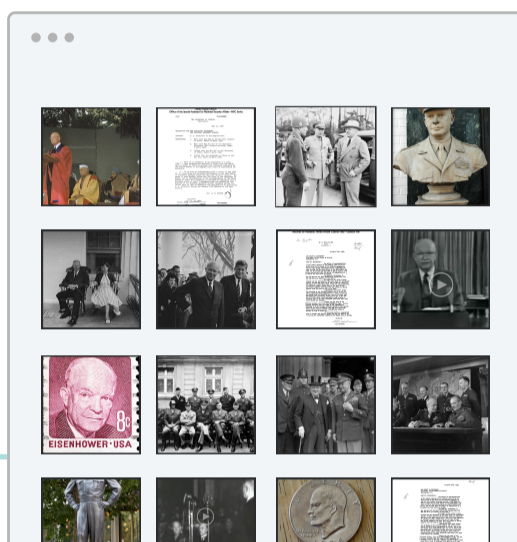

Management process

The AI Metadata Assistant generates descriptive metadata, extracts entities such as persons or buildings, and links related materials. Specto allows subject-matter experts to tag entities and update metadata in bulk.
